Roman Baths Museum

The best time to visit them in summer is the early morning midweek, because they are visited by many people.


The ticket price includes the audio-guide.

Bath Bus Company

It provides a city tour on a bus which stops approximately every twenty at the city's main attractions.

There's also a second route, the **Skyline Tour**, which goes to Prior Park and allows you to have an overview of the entire city from above.

Tickets for the service are valid for both routes.



There are also Tour Operators which offer boat trips along the River Ravon, like the **Avon Cruising** and the **Bath City Boat Trips**.



Alexandra Park

Alexandra Park is the best park to get fantastic panoramic view of Bath.

Its meadows and trees create a relaxing atmosphere. There are picnic areas and public baths; admission is free.

Prior Park

The Prior Park Landscape Garden is located inside a large valley with a magnificent view of the city. Along the tortuous paths you can find virtual tours which show you the garden's appearence in 1764.

At the bottom of the valley you can walk through the famous Palladino bridge and discover many surprising features.
